The environmental excellence challenge

The ENIMS solution

ENIMS performed a Code for Sustainable Homes ecology assessment at the development site. The Code evaluates new constructions according to a number of criteria, including ecology. Buildings achieve an overall level of between zero and six depending on how well they meet the standards – with high scores providing a very well recognised certification. Typically, a minimum number of credits are required for any new development.

Following the initial assessment, ENIMS was able to provide consultative advice to the organisation, in terms of how it could improve the ecological value of the site. This ensured the development was sustainable, and, in turn, helped the company to gain a high number of credits under the Code for Sustainable Homes.
